**EPA's Renovation, Repair and Painting Final Rule 40CFR 745:** Firms must be Certified by the EPA and have one or more Certified Renovators when disturbing lead-paint in pre 1978 homes or child-occupied facilities. Renovation Workers must also be trained.

Dust from renovations, repairs and surface preparation during painting activities creates potential lead hazards when lead-based paint is disturbed and lead-safe work practices are not used. EPA requires certification for renovation firms and training and certification for renovators. Prevention is the Goal. Lead dust from renovation work can cause lead poisoning in: children, pregnant women, yourself, other workers and even pets.

This course was developed by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to train Renovation, Repair and Painting contractors on how to work safely in housing with lead-based paint and comply with EPA's Renovation, Repair and painting (RRP) Rule and HUD's Lead Safe Housing Rule. Avoid EPA fines of up to \$37,500 for each violation.
